As a C337 Fire Detection Pilot, you will conduct VFR patrols in search of lightning and human-caused wildfires across Northern Ontario or Saskatchewan. Aerial Fire Detection plays a critical role in the government's wildfire management strategy to help ensure wildfires are found early when they are still small enough to be controlled.
