- Provides guidance to flight crews to ensure adherence to SOPs and other company procedures.
- Performs Pilot Proficiency Checks (PPCs)
- Backfills other birddog or detection pilot to support extra hires, company flying, as required
- Assume any responsibilities delegated by the Chief Pilot or Operations Manager
